

PURPOSES and POLICIES of the FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY BOOK SALE

Purposes:

1. The book sale tries to foster reading in the community by disseminating books at a low price.
2. The book sale helps to provide funds to support Friends of the Library (FOL) projects.
3. The book sale tries to encourage good community relations and use of library resources by bringing people into the library.

Policies:

1. The first day of the book sale is open only to FOL members and CRDL staff.
2. FOL book sale workers and CRDL staff may set aside up to ten (10) books in advance of the sale. These books should be paid for and taken on the first day of the sale.
3. Dealers may not buy FOL memberships, but are allowed at the book sale during a specified time.
4. Each year, the book Chairperson(s) will determine items to be excluded.
5. Charitable, non-profit, organizations may have any books remaining after 3:00 p.m. on the final afternoon of the sale.
6. Book sale procedures should be evaluated annually.
